<p>English Our focus this term is travelling writing. Nimbus will be engaging with language choices, structural features and correct grammar when writing to promote travelling.</p>	<p>Science Nimbus are continuing with the chemistry units of the syllabus. This term they will be focusing their learning on the Periodic Table. They will learn how to read the table and use it to answer scientific questions.</p>		<p>Maths Nimbus will be looking at a number of different topics this term. Some students will be working on basic number skills; adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Other students will be looking at topics such as angles, constructions and circles.</p>
<p>Art Nimbus have been working around the key work of “embellishment” this term, and have been exploring different methods of decoration. They have also been continuing to work on their long term projects around the theme of “self”. This term will have a particular focus on developing watercolor skills.</p>	<p>PE Nimbus will be looking at personal fitness this term. They will be going to the local gym and planning/using a personalised training programme that focuses on targets set by the students themselves as to what they want to achieve.</p>		<p>PSHE This term Nimbus will be learning about drugs and alcohol. They will learn about the effects that drugs and alcohol can have on our bodies and our communities.</p>
<p>ICT In ICT, Nimbus will sort and organise information and present it in different forms using Excel and Word. They will use simple editing and formatting techniques to develop their work and learn about how to use ICT safely when accessing Social Media.</p>	<p>Social Skills/SALT: Nimbus will continue to work on their social skills with a focus on speaking and listening and regulating their emotions and sensory input.</p>	<p>History: Nimbus are continuing to study the Norman Conquest. Nimbus will complete a case study on The Battle of Hastings. Nimbus will look at how King William took control of England after The Battle of Hastings.</p>	<p>Cooking This term the students will be preparing recipes using pasta for main dishes, practicing the skills of boiling, simmering, sautéing and recognising when food is cooked (ie onions, mushrooms, bacon and mince). They will also be preparing a fruit crumble practicing peeling, slicing and using the rubbing in method for making the crumble topping. Hygiene in the kitchen, safety when using the hob and oven and handling and storing sharp knives will also be discussed and practised by the students.</p>
